NOVEC Member Michael McSellers: A Life Driven by Faith, Family, and Service

⁶⁶ A life lived without a purpose, is a wasted life. But, a life lived in him for his purpose, is a life in the end we all can be proud of.²⁹

his is the life motto of Virginia State Trooper Michael McSellers of Haymarket, who was awarded the 2015 Governor's Award for Public Service in Volunteerism and Service by Govenor Terry McAuliffe last year.

The year marked the 15th anniversary of the awards, which honor and celebrate the contributions of public-sector employees to the Commonweal thin seven different categories: Governor's Agency Star, Career Achievement, Community Service and Volunteerism, Customer Service, Innovation, Teamwork, and Workhake Health, Wellness and Safetx.

McSellers' community involvement ranges from feeding the homeless, to mentoring and coaching young men in sports as well as life skills, organizing fundraising events for the Special Olympics, to travelling hundreds of miles to provide supplies and a helping hand to those in need after a natural disaster.

The news release from the governor's office said, "Trooper Mike McSellers' service to his community is truly a model for all citizens."

Upon finding out he would be honored at the Executive Mansion, McSellers says he was shocked, overwhelmed, and felt somewhat undeserving. However, his wife, LaKeta, who has been by his side supporting his service to the community, offered her husband words of encouragement.

"The first thing my wife said to me was, 'Everything you do, you do with a pure heart and because of that, you are being honored,'" McSellers recalls.

Volunteering Is 'Life Changing'

"Volunteering my time and investing myself in someone in need is truly my passion," he says. "It is important to do these things because it lets people know you care about them and they are not alone."

McSellers believes serving others can be life-altering for all involved. The NOVEC member says volunteering not only changes the lives of those in need, but it is a priceless experience for those who serve.

He has turned serving the community into a family affair as his daughter Jaylen, 14, and son Jovan, 11, often join their parents in their volunteer efforts.

"It's important to get my kids involved with volunteering to let them know there are people out there who don't have what we have and it helps build character as they grow into adults," McSellers says. "I can honesily say my kids have a heart to serve others and that makes me proud."

The young McSellerses even ask their parents when and where they will be volunteering next.

Greatest Impact

Trooper McSellers' efforts to serve are not limited to Northern Virginia. Along with members of his church, he has travelled as far as Arkansas and Oklahoma to provide support to people devastated by natural disasters; one of which has made a lasting impact on his life.

In 2013, members of Park Valley Church in Haymarket collected supplies that filled two 24-foot moving trucks as well as 55,000 in donations for the people of Moore. Oklahoma, following the devastating tornado that ripped through their town on May 20, 2013. Volunteers, including McSellers, made the drive from Northern Virginia to Central Oklahoma to deliver the donations to families that had lost everything.

"To see the reactions on their faces was well worth the 26-hour drive," McSellers remembers. "Even if it was just for that, it was well worth it. I will never forget that moment."






















- Know the symptoms of PTS.


